Ages 2+



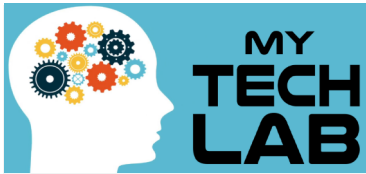

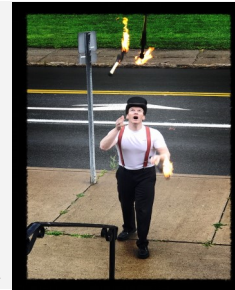
