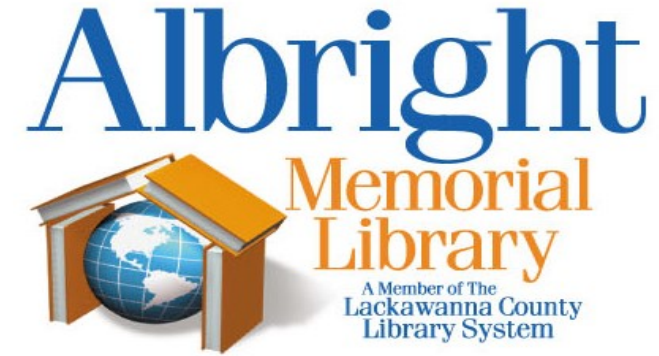

Internet Resource Classes

Google Services

Gmail, Drive, Docs, Sheets, Maps and more will be discussed in this class about the various free services Google offers.

Internet Safety

Viruses, trojans, spyware, phishing, and spam are covered in this class all about keeping you and your information safe online.

Facebook 101

How to setup a Facebook account, set privacy settings, post comments, create events, and more will be covered.

What's the Cloud?

This class discusses what exactly is meant by the cloud and some popular cloud services such as iCloud, DropBox, and Google Drive.

Online Selling

This class is an introduction to eBay and online selling. Topics will include creating listings, uploading pictures, Buy it Now versus standard auctions, shipping charges, and PayPal.

Microsoft Office Classes

Word 2013 (3 Sessions)

Students will explore the various components of the Microsoft Office Word 2013 environment, create documents, edit documents, format text/paragraphs, and add graphic elements to a document.

Prerequisite: Basic computer knowledge and experience with the keyboard/mouse

Beginner Excel 2013 (3 Sessions)

Students will learn to create basic worksheets and workbooks, modify and format worksheets, use calculations, create their own formulas, customize worksheet and workbook layouts, and print workbook contents.

Prerequisite: Basic computer knowledge and experience with the keyboard/mouse

PowerPoint 2013(3 Sessions)

Students will learn to customize the PowerPoint environment, add diagrams to presentations, add special effects to a PowerPoint presentation, and use the various options to customize slide shows.

Prerequisite: Beginner Word

Intermediate Excel 2013 (3 Sessions)

Students will learn to edit and format multiple worksheets, grouping worksheets for editing, constructing formulas on a grouped worksheet, constructing formulas that refer to cells in another worksheet, concatenate, and inserting sparklines.

Prerequisite: Beginner Excel

Excel 2013 Pivot Tables & More(2 Sessions)

Students will learn to create and use pivot tables/charts, if functions, v lookup, goal seek, circular references, and working with ranges.

Prerequisite: Intermediate Excel

Excel 2013 V Lookup(1 Session)

Students will learn to create and use V Lookup and other associated functions.

Publisher(2 Sessions)

Students will learn how to create high quality brochures and other documents with Microsoft Publisher.
