


WHAT IS BOOKS BY MAIL?

The Books by Mail Program is a free service which provides library materials for those who are physically handicapped or legally blind and cannot visit the library.

WHAT CAN YOU RECEIVE?

With your Books by Mail
Library card, you can get
DVDs, Blu-Rays, Books,
Audio Books, and CDs, all for
a four-week loan period and
delivered to your door.





TO RECEIVE BOOKS BY MAIL

- 1. You must be a resident of Lackawanna County.
- 2. You must provide a medical note stating you are physically handicapped or legally blind.
- 3. You must leave your library card at the Scranton Public Library. If you do not have a library card, an application can be mailed.
- 4. Library materials will be mailed postage paid in a nylon bag. The bags may be returned to your local mail carrier or to any U.S. Post Office.
