In compliance with the requirements of 15 Pa. C.S. § 7316 (relating to articles of incorporation the undersigned, desiring to be incorporated as a nonprofit corporation hereby certifies (certify) that:

1. The name of the corporation is:

Taylor Public Library Association

2. The location and post office address of the initial registered offices of the corporation in this Commonwealth is:

200 Union Street, Taylor, Pennsylvania 18517

3. The corporation is incorporated under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the following purpose or purposes:

To provide, maintain, and perpetuate a free, public library for the general public..

4. The corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis and shall have no authority to issue shares of stock. The corporation is not organized for profit, and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.

5. The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

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7. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, Board of Directors, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 3 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (Including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

~~8. All conditions, qualifications, requirements, privileges and regulations as to membership in the Corporation, including voting rights shall be fixed and governed by the By-laws of the Corporation.~~

9. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of and transfer all of its assets to the Scranton Public Library, and if the said Scranton Public Library shall no longer be in existence, shall dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation, in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or literary purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, as the Directors shall determine.
